CARE & MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

How to keep your Weis/Poly HDPE Solid Plastic toilet partitions beautiful for many years

Weis/Poly solid plastic toilet partitions are virtually maintenance free compared to the other toilet partitions that are available in the marketplace today. Just as in any other room of your building, your toilet partitions are exposed to use and atmospheric conditions that will require cleaning from time to time.

GRAFFITI & DIRT

The following methods of cleaning can be used to keep your Weis/Poly, solid plastic toilet partitions always looking their best:

- Use a clean, damp, non-abrasive cotton cloth to wipe down all surfaces.
- In the event that a deeper cleaning is needed, use a garden hose with a pressure nozzle to remove the dirt. Wipe the toilet partitions dry to avoid unsightly watermarks.
- It is best to wash graffiti from your toilet partitions immediately using commercial grade products such as 409, Simple Green, etc.*

CUTS & SCRATCHES

You can repair cuts and scratches by carefully burnishing the surface with a smooth round object such as a screwdriver handle or a spoon.

Using the smooth round object, apply pressure to the cut or scratched surface and burnish with, not against, the cut or scratch.

Upon completing any repairs for your partitions, spray the surface of your panels and/or doors with a silicone spray to give your Weis/Poly product back its original bright and glossy finish – *Just like new again.*

HARDWARE MAINTENANCE

Use a clean, damp, non-abrasive cotton cloth to wipe down all surfaces. Do not use any abrasives cleaning agents on any of the partitions and/or partition hardware.

All hanger bolts, brackets, hinges, latches and other fastening devices should be checked at least twice per year. It is important to check your partition hardware so that you can replace or tighten all loose or broken items at once.
